A folder detailing the location of all recorded church and churchyard memorials has (finally!) been completed and is available in St. Hugh's. It is now possible to look up a Quethiock ancestor and then locate their memorial in the church or churchyard. An online database, The National Burial Grounds Survey, will be available for Quethiock fairly soon, however it will not include every memorial in St. Hugh's due to some being broken or displaced. The folder does include these. This gravestone is one of only four fragments that we have been unable to identify - it is dated 1595 and seems to have been a floorstone inside the church. The list of memorials that have been located is on the St. Hugh's website.
